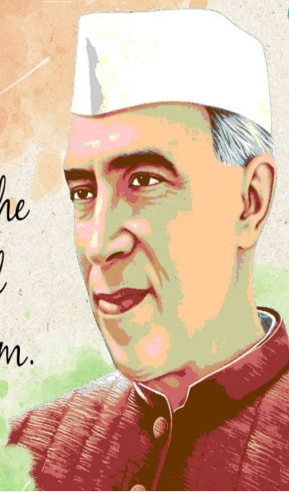

will be nice."

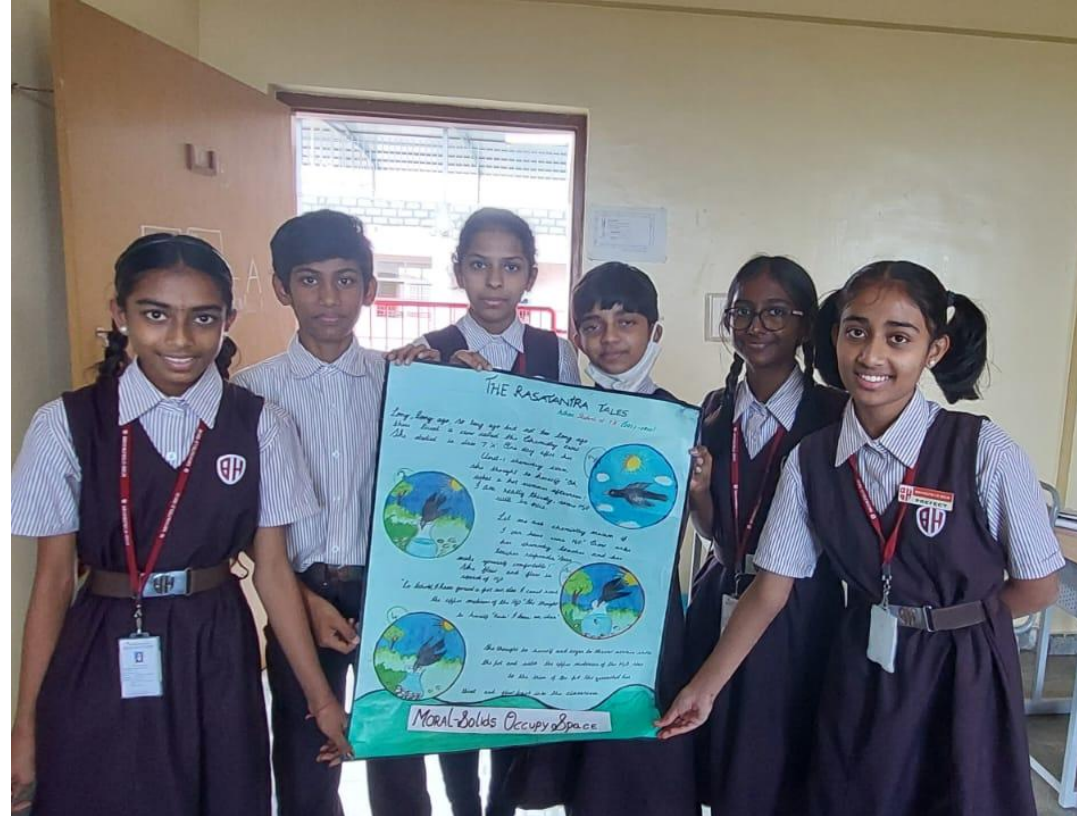
Let me ask chemistry ma'am if

search of  $H_2O$ .

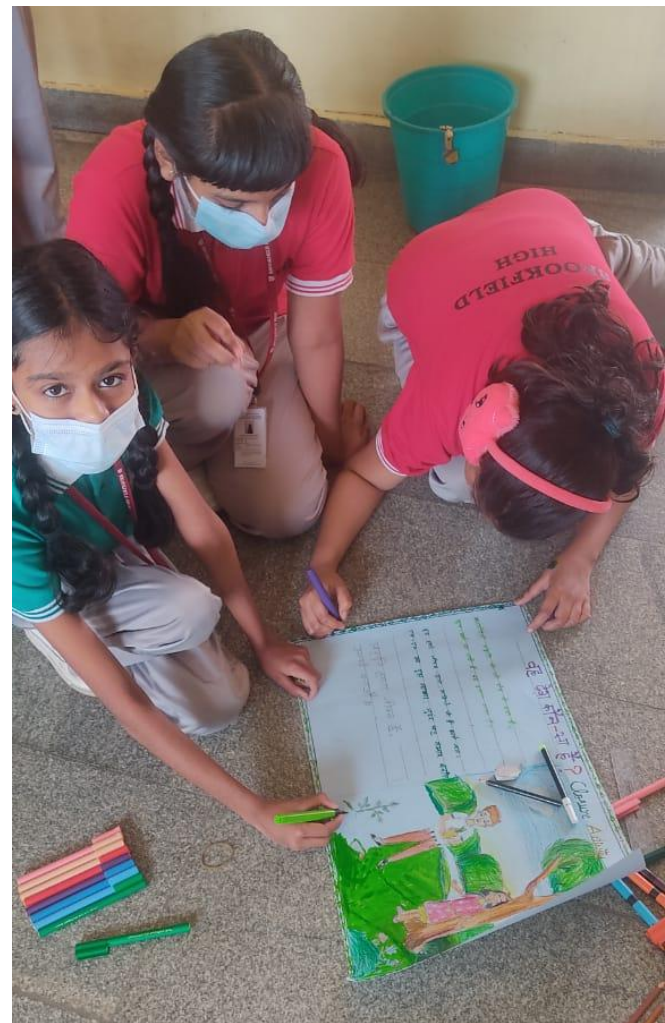
"Lo behot, I have found a pot but, alas I cannot reach

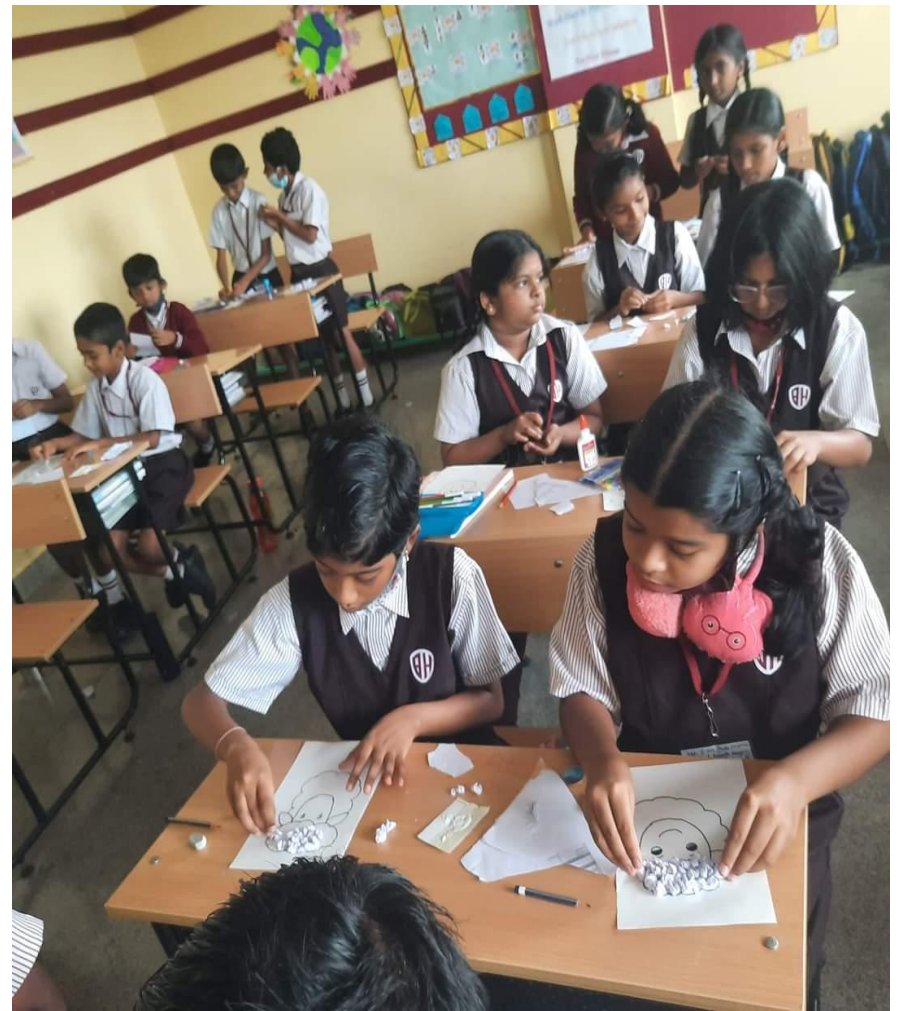
